Currently, 82.8% of the 27,703 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 14.0%, renter occupied; and 3.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 27,186 housing units in the area - 84.7% owner occupied, 11.2% renter occupied, and 4.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.84%. Median home value in the area is \$354,658, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.94% annually to \$371,648.
